No Bullies, Please!

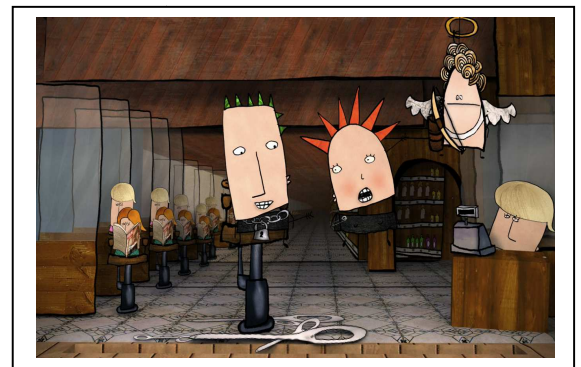
Take a Stand
